3) Voting Items

a. Public Meeting Minutes 3.24.22

The meeting minutes were reviewed from 3.24.22. A motion was made by Richard DuVarney to approve the minutes as submitted. The motion was seconded by Jamie Green. Motion was carried unanimously.

b. 2022.2023 STTAEAC Budget and Allocations V2

Rachelle comments that with the COLA increase there will need to be an allocation amendment and budget will need to switch to option B. Jim Cloney proposes to craft the motion to keep allotments the same in percentages and then adjusting by the funded COLA. A motion was made by Todd Brose to give flexibility to adjust funding according to COLA increase. The motion was seconded by Steve Henson. Motion was carried unanimously.

c. Executive Committee- Chair & Co-chair

a. Regional Workgroups – Healthcare Pathways, CTE, High School

Diploma/Equivalency Prep, Technology - Rachelle Modena proposes the need to bring together regional work groups within the small county regions. Rachelle announces that conversations should begin in the fall to identify the need and capacity to bring this to the community.

b. 22.23 Budget Planning Process - Rachelle reviews the Consortium budget and estimates that \$22,000-\$25,000 should be available for one-time funds.

c. Consortium Update – Budget, Activity, Staffing – Rachelle Modena highlights the success and great outcomes of the pilot that was tested this year at Shasta Adult School, where students can test out of high school subjects.
