a. Public Meeting Minutes 6.16.22

The meeting minutes were reviewed from 6.16.22. A motion was made by Steve Henson to approve the minutes as submitted. The motion was seconded by Jamie Green. Motion was carried unanimously.

b. One-time Funds 2022.2023/Special Meeting

Rachelle states that there are unspent consortium funds from 2021.2022 available. A motion was made by Frank Nigro to approve the process to allocate these funds through an application process and a scheduled special meeting. The motion was seconded by Peggy Canale. The motion was carried unanimously. Rachelle proposed to schedule the special meeting on Thursday October 6, 2022 at 3 pm. All present members tentatively agreed to the meeting date and time.

#### 4) Informational/Discussion Items

- **a.** Success Story Trinity Alps, Sandy Coatney
  - Sandy Coatney with Trinity Alps informs Consortium of two students who have been successful in adult school this past year. The first student graduated and received his Diploma in August and has moved on to earn a living wage through employment. The second student has faced many barriers and was able to reduce his credits from needing 60 credits to needing 6 credits to graduate and is on track to graduate by the end of next week.
- b. 21.22 Student Data Rachelle reviews data from 21.22. She notes there has been an increase in "Adult Education Enrollments" and an increase in "Students with 12+ Hours of Instruction". It is also noted that there has been a decrease in "Increased Educational Functioning Level" due to not documenting students who have progressed. Rachelle mentions that there have been a significant number of achievements during 21.22, but not as significant of an increase in "Total Hours of Instruction". Lastly, Rachelle reviews 21.22 data broken down by program/school.
- c. Consortium Update Budget, Activity, and Staffing Rachelle Modena reviews the 21.22 budget summary, as well as the current budget summary. Rachelle notes that the budget is on target. Rachelle also reviews tasks completed by Consortium Director and Student Services Coordinator and she highlights 22.23 pilot projects.

#### 3) Voting Items

- a. 22.23 One-Time Funds Rachelle announces more One-Time Funds were requested than were available between Corning, TCOE, and Shasta College. Rachelle proposes different funding options to reduce the funding. A motion was made by Rich DuVarney to split the overage of \$1,891 between Shasta College and TCOE. The motion was seconded by Steven Henson. Motion was carried unanimously.
- b. GED/HISET Rachelle proposes the idea to change the wording in the STTAEC Guiding document to be more explicit regarding the ability to award high school credit for sections of the HiSET or GED that were passed previously to enrolling in one of our adult schools. Rachelle clarifies that if you are a GED testing site, you cannot award high school diploma credits for passing sections of the GED. A motion was made by Jaime

Green to support this rewording of the document as a new policy. The motion was seconded by Rich DuVarney. The motion was carried unanimously.
