Classes will be held primarily at the Trinity County Office of Education, however, these classes can go mobile depending upon needs in our county. In addition to the required face-to-face six 1 and 1/2 hour sessions, participants will be able to ask questions and submit assignments in our online google classroom.

Love and Logic Early Childhood Parenting Made Fun! (For parents and grandparents of children ages birth to 6):

The person leading the class is an independent facilitator and does not work for the Love and Logic Institute.

Class Description-

When parents start using the strategies of Love and Logic early in their children's lives, they dramatically up the odds that the teenage years will be fun...instead of frantic. They also create kids who'll begin school ready to learn...instead of ready to drive their teachers batty. You will learn techniques that help:

- 1. Show your tots that whining and arguing does not pay.
- 2. Put an end to misbehavior in public.
- 3. Smooth-out mornings and bedtimes
- 4. Calm sibling bickering and battling
- 5. Take the battle out of mealtimes, tooth brushing, bathing, etc.
- 6. Make potty training fun
- 7. Teach respect, responsibility and self-discipline
- 8. And much, much more!

This class will be held over a period of 5 weeks at 1 and 1/2 hour sessions for a total of five sessions. TCOE also provides a "train the trainer" option which allows us to teach the above mentioned Love and Logic classes to learners who want to train others in their communities. The Train the trainer option is put on throughout the year based on need. Those who complete the training will be able to facilitate Love and Logic in their communities.
