Introduction to Welding

This course is FREE, no charge for attending!!

This introductory course will provide hands on experience plus classroom instruction to prepare adults (18+) for **entry level** welding employment with companies such as Lentec, Smith Ranches, Pneumatic Conveying Manufacturing, Waste Management, QRC, Sierra Pacific, Industrial Welding, Driscoll Strawberries, etc.

According to the Employment Development Department, the **average wage** for Welder in Northern California is \$12-18 per hour.

Course Description: Introduction to weld positions in flat and horizontal, including welding safety, Oxy Acet Welding and cutting (OAW), shielded metal arc welding (SMAW), gas metal arc welding (GMAW), plasma arc cutting (PAC), air carbon arc cutting and gouging (CAC-A) welding and cutting processes. Training also includes base metal, shielded metal arc welding electrodes, joint fit-up and alignment, groove welds with backing, and open V-groove welds. A certificate of completion will be available for students who meet all attendance and course requirements certificate of proficiency.
