

Welding/Metal Shop Skills

Course Description: In this introductory class, students will learn about job seeking strategies, self-marketing techniques and basic workplace skills. Students will learn the basic fundamentals of three welding processes, SMAW (stick welding), GMAW (mig or wire welding), and O A- W (oxygen acetylene welding) along with all the safety precautions related to each individual weld process. Additionally, students will learn to operate and use all hand tools safety in relation to the welding industry along with all other equipment in the metal shop. Students who meet all the requirements of the class will leave with a certificate of completion listing the total hours spent in the shop, along with the skills acquired that can be included with job applications and resumes.
