e) 20.21 Budget/Allocations

Rachelle Modena stated that there will be a 12.1% reduction to Adult Education; Reducing STTACE by \$141, 473

Option A: Leave the Student Service Coordinator Position vacant a \$35,000 – 40,000 savings.

Option B: Reduce Consortium Director (Rachelle Modena) contract to 11 months. Leave SSS vacant.

Jim Cloney proposed if Rachelle Modena moves to an 11 month contract that once funds are available Rachelle is restored to a 12 month position if possible.

Victor Hopper motioned to accept Option B.

Rachelle discussed the need to provide consortium guidance around offering a reduced credit diploma modeling the opportunity in legislation for those under 18. Rachelle will work on a draft to present at the September meeting.

Adverse Circumstance Reduced Credit Diploma

Introduction: California legislation and Education Code support a reduced credit high school diploma for minors who experience adverse circumstances while a minor in high school. Current ed code (EC 51225.1 and 51225.5) does not support this reduced credit diploma for students once they turn 18. The reduced credit high school diploma is offered to students who have experienced one or more of the following:

Homelessness (AB 1806/216), Foster Care (AB 167/216), Juvenile Court School (AB 2306)

Military Family (AB 365), Migratory Child (AB 2121)

In addition, the student must have transferred schools in the 3rd and or 4th year of high school and subsequently fell behind in high school credits and cannot reasonably graduate in a 5th year of high school.

Adult school staff will utilize student school transcripts to identify students who may be eligible for a reduced credit diploma when a school transfer is noted after 10th grade. Through an intake process, staff can inquire about the student's homelessness, foster care, juvenile court, military, or migratory status if not formally noted on the transcript. If a student disclosed an adverse circumstance that is not noted on their transcript the student will be asked to provide documentation of the adverse circumstance. Due to the age of the student, formal documentation may not be available for all situations. A signed declaration of the adverse circumstance may be accepted on a case by case basis. For any students that cannot provide formal documentation, the signed student declaration will be approved by the adult school administrator, admitting the declaration as the formal documentation.
